

Privacy Statement

General

Company Webcast B.V. , having its corporate seat in Rotterdam, the Netherlands (hereinafter, together with its subsidiaries and affiliates, "CWC"), understands and respect the importance of your privacy. The purpose of this Privacy statement is to inform you of the ways in which CWC is processing your personal data. By 'personal data' we mean any personally identifiable information.

Scope

General

- To provide the basic functionality of the Website;

What is a cookie?
